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FORM 2: DIAGNOSTIC ASSESSMENT FOR SKILL ANALYSIS

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Preparation

Print a class supply of the *Comprehensive Phonics Survey—Diagnostic Assessment* and the *Comprehensive Phonics Survey—Diagnostic Assessment: Individual Scoring Sheet*. Also print a copy of the *Comprehensive Phonics Survey—Diagnostic Assessment: Class Record Sheet* (Form 2b).

Administering the Assessment

Administer the *Comprehensive Phonics Survey—Diagnostic Assessment*, one child at a time, in the class three times a year—at the beginning, middle, and end.

1. Show the child the *Comprehensive Phonics Survey* (Form 2a). Explain to the child that he or she is to read each word. Point out that the words in the first column are nonsense, or made up, words. The words in the second column are real words.
2. Have the child point to each word and read it aloud. Circle each correct response. Record the child's errors on the *Comprehensive Phonics Survey—Diagnostic Assessment: Individual Scoring Sheet* to use for error analysis (for example, *send* for *smend*). Record the number correct and note the speed in the boxes for each part of the assessment.

Scoring the Assessment

1. Count a word correct if the pronunciation is correct according to common sound-spelling relationships.
2. Total the number of words the child read correctly. Analyze the mispronounced words, looking for patterns that might give you information about the child's decoding strengths and weaknesses.

Appendices: Assessments

3. Focus future instruction on those sound-spelling relationship categories (e.g., short vowels, long vowels) in which the child made three or more errors.
4. Use the *Comprehensive Phonics Survey—Diagnostic Assessment: Class Record Sheet* (Form 2b) to record all children's scores for each testing period to determine small-group differentiated instructional needs.
